Ron Castaldi of **Partsmaster** opened January's meeting by introducing their Canadian Sales manager, **Dave McIntyre**. Dave gave us some history of Partsmaster and let us know that if or when we need support, he and his sales team are there for us. He also introduced a new sales team member, **Brady McIntyre**. Ron, Dave and Brady wanted to demonstrate some of their newest tools, so after the meal we headed down to the shop to test some out. Ron showed how their new **Cryo Boost** step drills and Mag drill with **Partsmaster** cryo drill bits went through the metal work piece like butter. The new bits are smooth all the way through the cut and will not catch as they exit the steel. Ron also showed us a Partsmaster framed Hacksaw with their carbide blade, used for cutting hardened metals. The Partsmaster team then went on to show us some of their new work **LED** lights. One of the LED lights is a super powerful, compact, rechargeable work light with magnetic base. They even displayed a 110 Volt shop light that has 3 LED tubes that can be formed in a convex or concave shape and produces over 5400 Lumens. To top it all off, Dave gave away a rechargeable Aqua work light and an Intrinsically safe LED flashlight. Thank you Dave, Ron and Brady for a great night.
