We need to say a special thank you **Steven Daniels** and **Snap-On training** for volunteering to give us a special information and diagnostics session for our February meeting. Steven has been in the industry for 30 years and seen an amazing amount of growth at Snap-On. He touched on many areas of diagnostics including their newest addition, Harley Davidson. Steven talked about how using a top of the line scan tool can dig deeper in diagnostics to show more codes than a standard code reader. He also talked about the difference between a relearn and a flash, as well as where to purchase flash codes from manufacturers. He stressed the importance of using a high end battery charger when you are performing a flash program and also showed us how high end diagnostic tools can graph data, show waveforms and solve problems in electronics. Another important item he mentioned was to always check to see if a "reset" is needed when you install new electronic parts. One of the newest tools to hit the market is Thermal Imaging. Thermal imaging is a wonderful new tool that can show you a picture like image of components to give advance warning of failing components before they have actually failed. Steven finished the evening with some updates of what is happening at Snap-On and some of the companies that they are buying.
